BE:**

- U.S. citizen
- At least 18 years old on Election Day
- A resident of Minnesota for 20 days
- Finished with all parts of any felony sentence

- Register to vote online—it's quick and easy at mnvotes.org
- Or complete a registration form and mail it to your county elections office
 - Or register at your polling place on Election Day

GO VOTE
